Fiscal Year Summary

In fiscal 2023, the World Bank (IBRD/IDA) committed **\$72.8 billion** to partner countries, distributed in credits, loans, and grants.

Fiscal Year Summary

In fiscal 2023, IBRD committed **\$38.6** billion for 136 new operations, of which six were IBRD and IDA blended operations.

IDA committed **\$34.2** billion for **192** new operations, of which six were IBRD and IDA blended operations.

Fiscal Year Summary

Support to countries from IBRD rose to **\$38.6 billion** in fiscal 2023.

Fiscal Year Summary

Commitments from IDA were at **\$34.2** in fiscal 2023. These commitments included **\$27.0 billion** in credits and **\$7.3 billion** in grants.

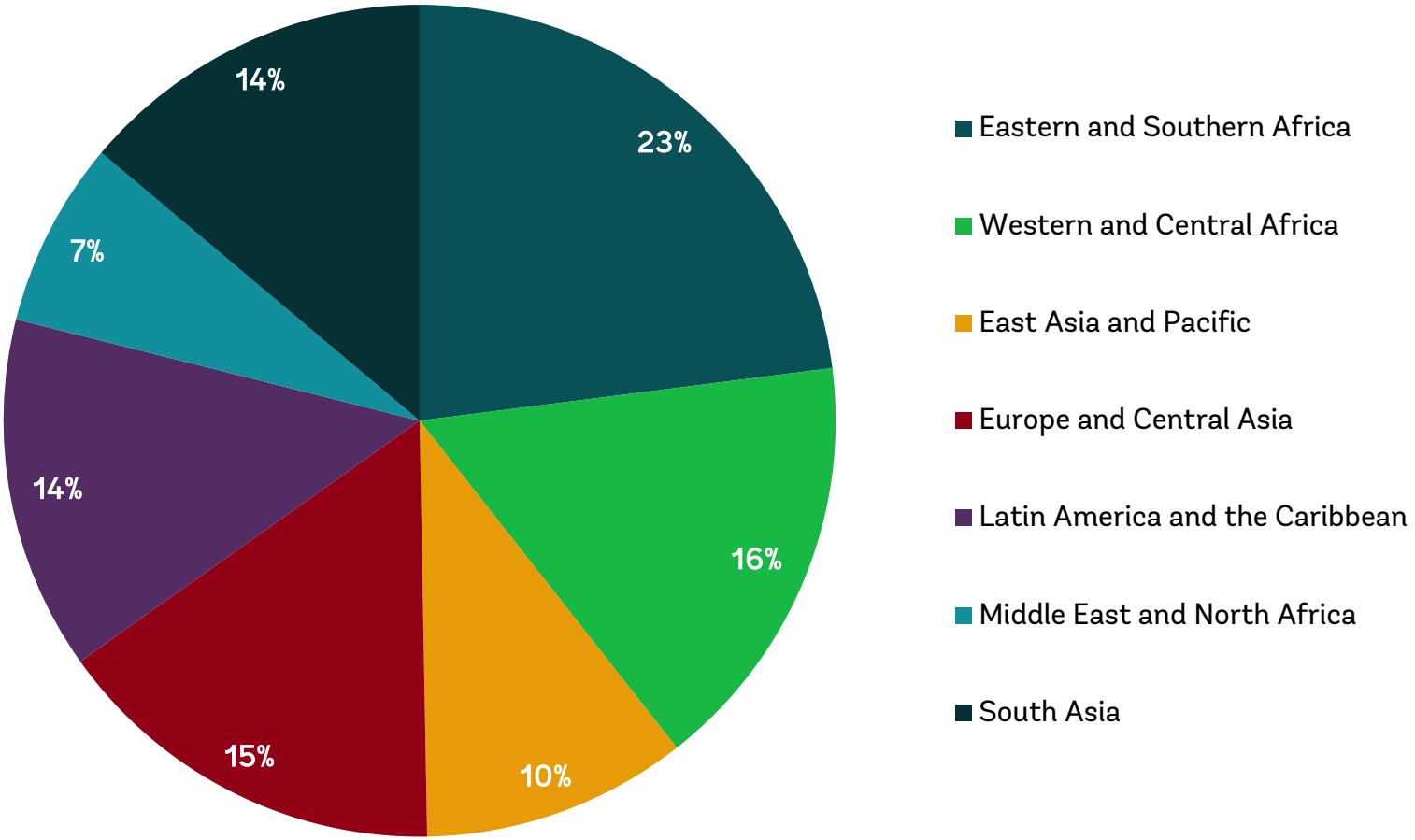

IBRD and IDA Lending by Region | Fiscal 2023

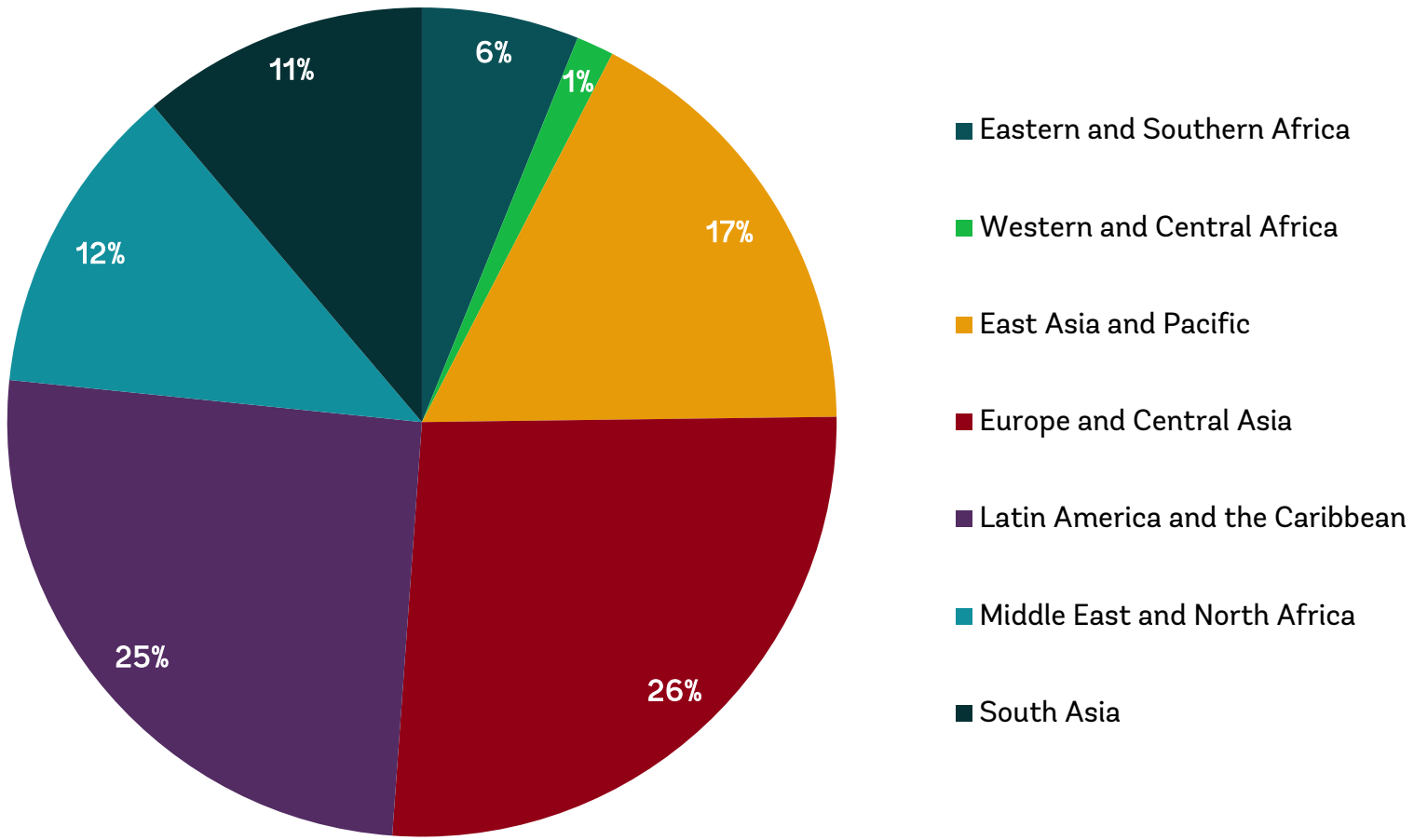
Share of total lending of \$72.8 billion

Share of total lending of \$38.6 billion

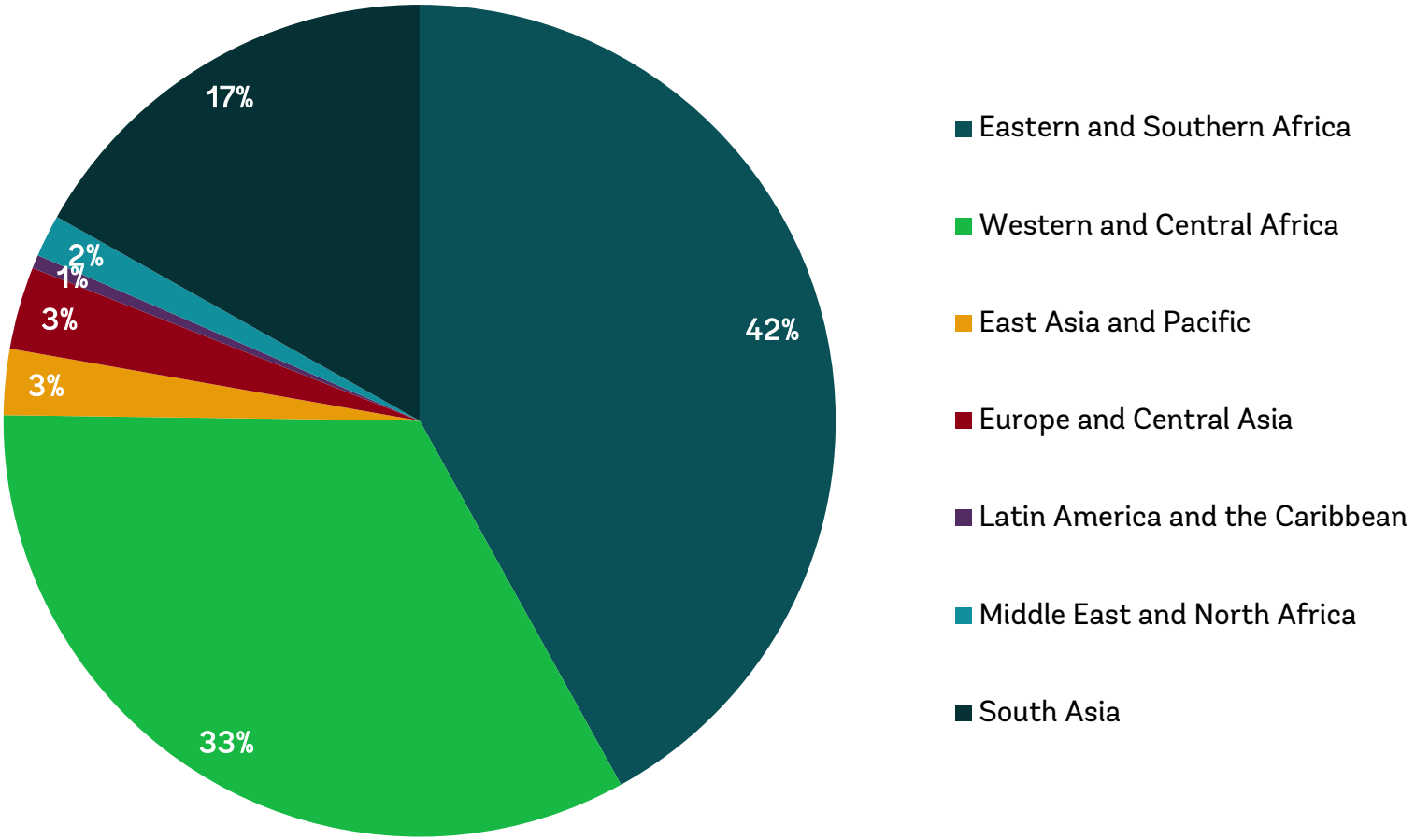

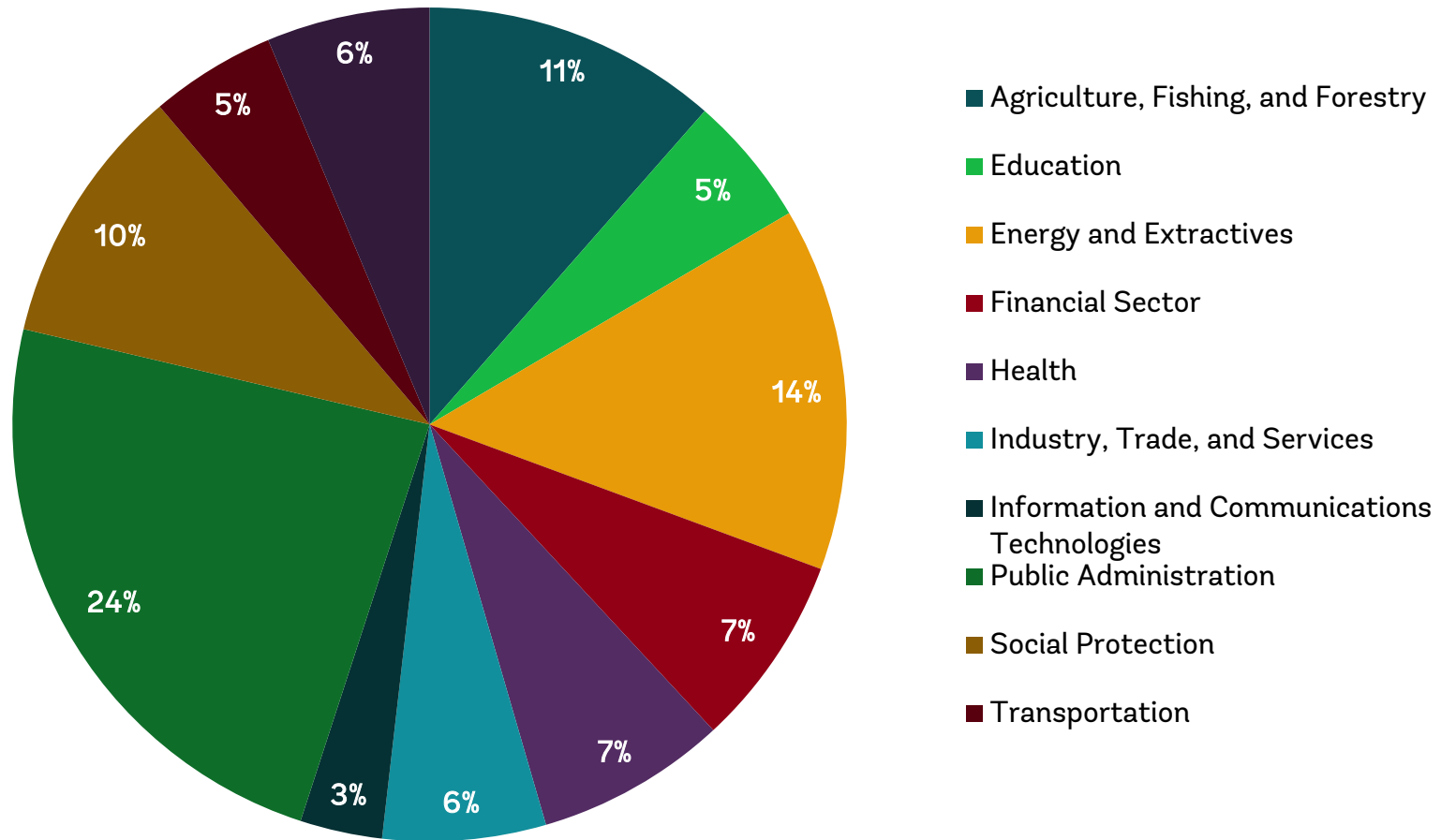
IDA Lending by Region | Fiscal 2023

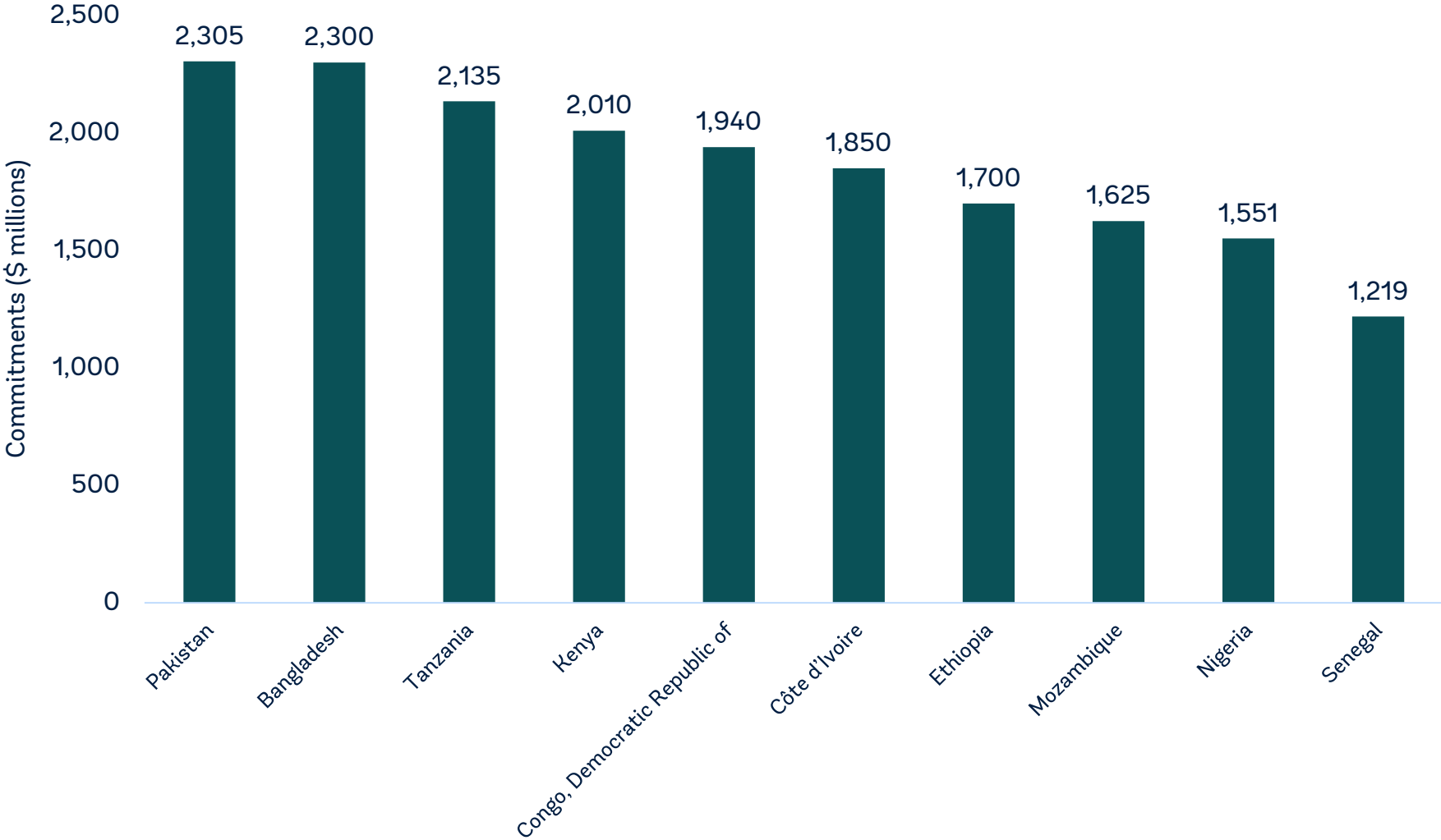

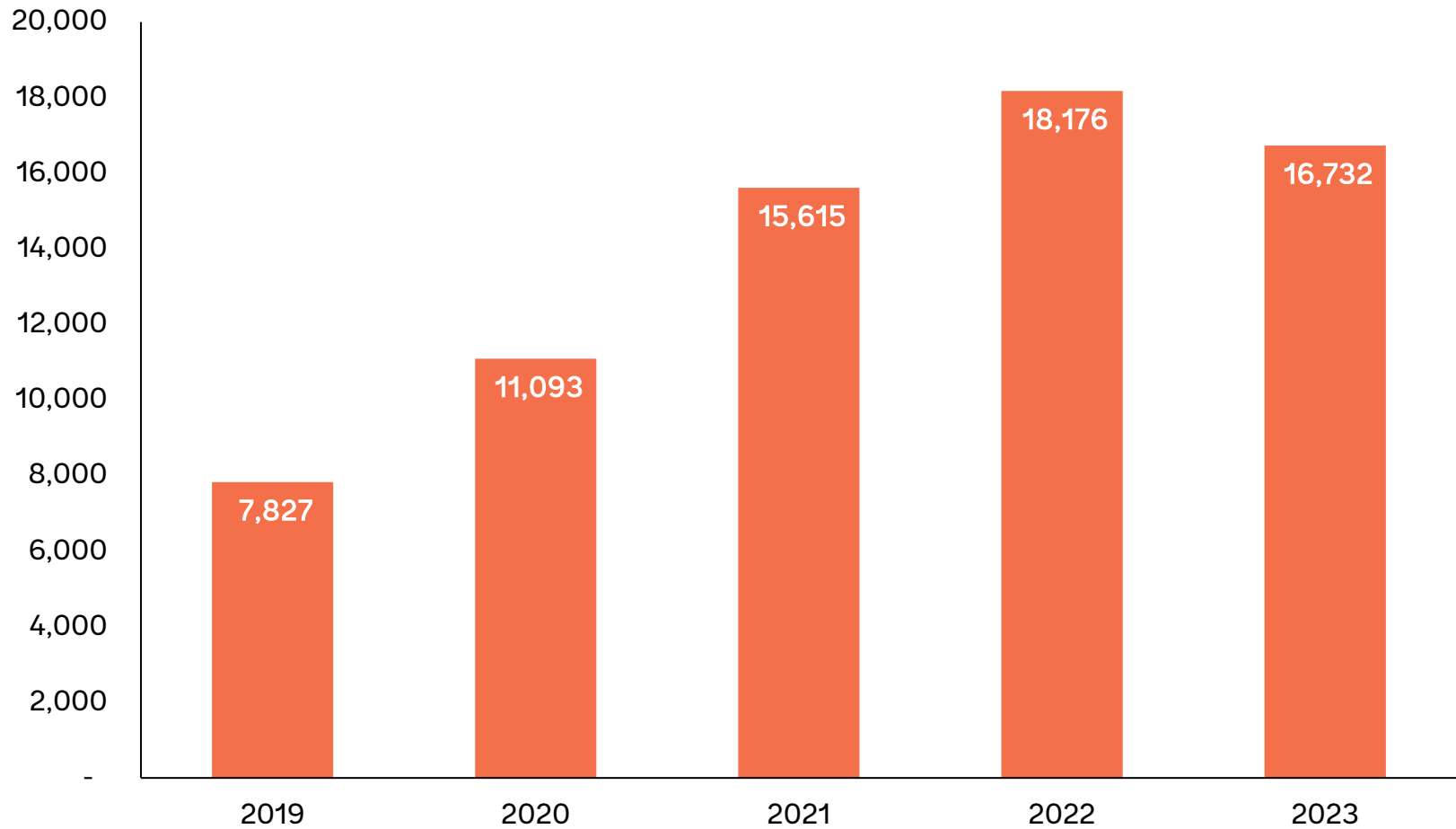

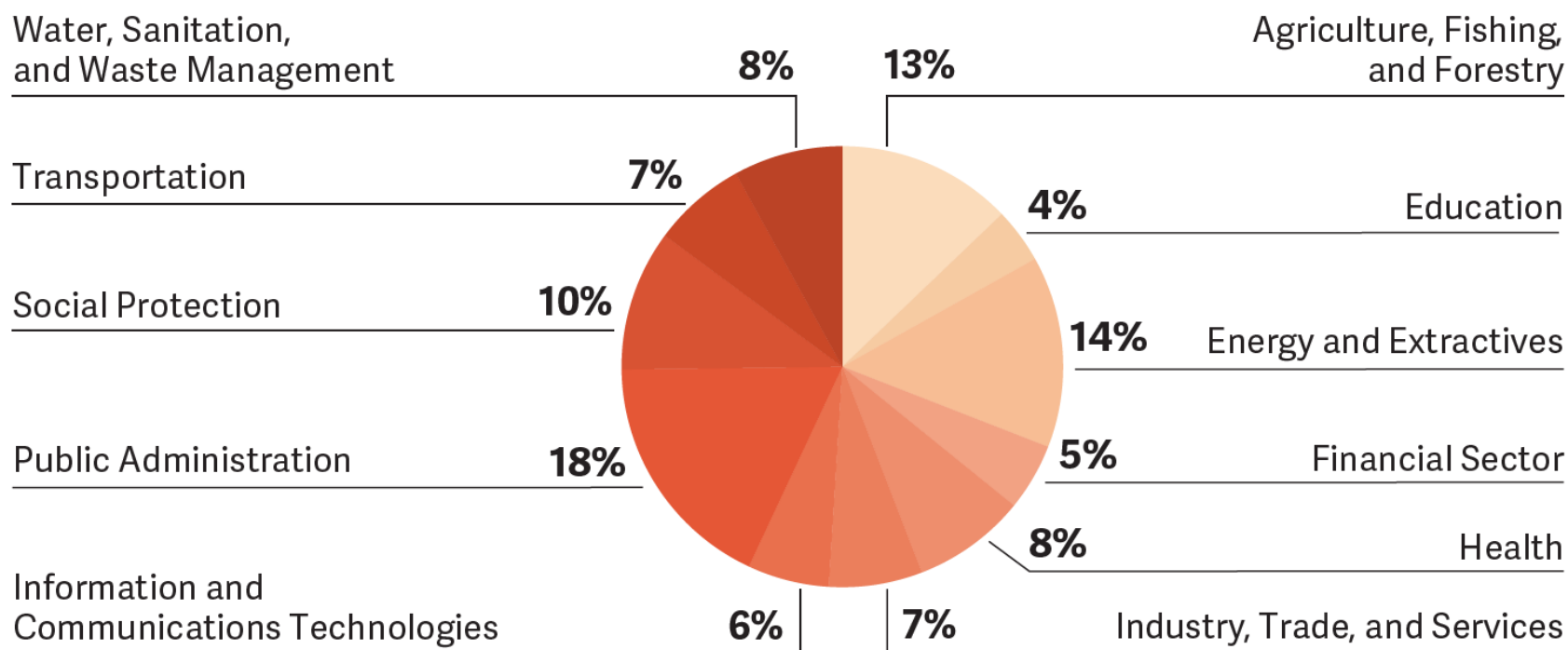

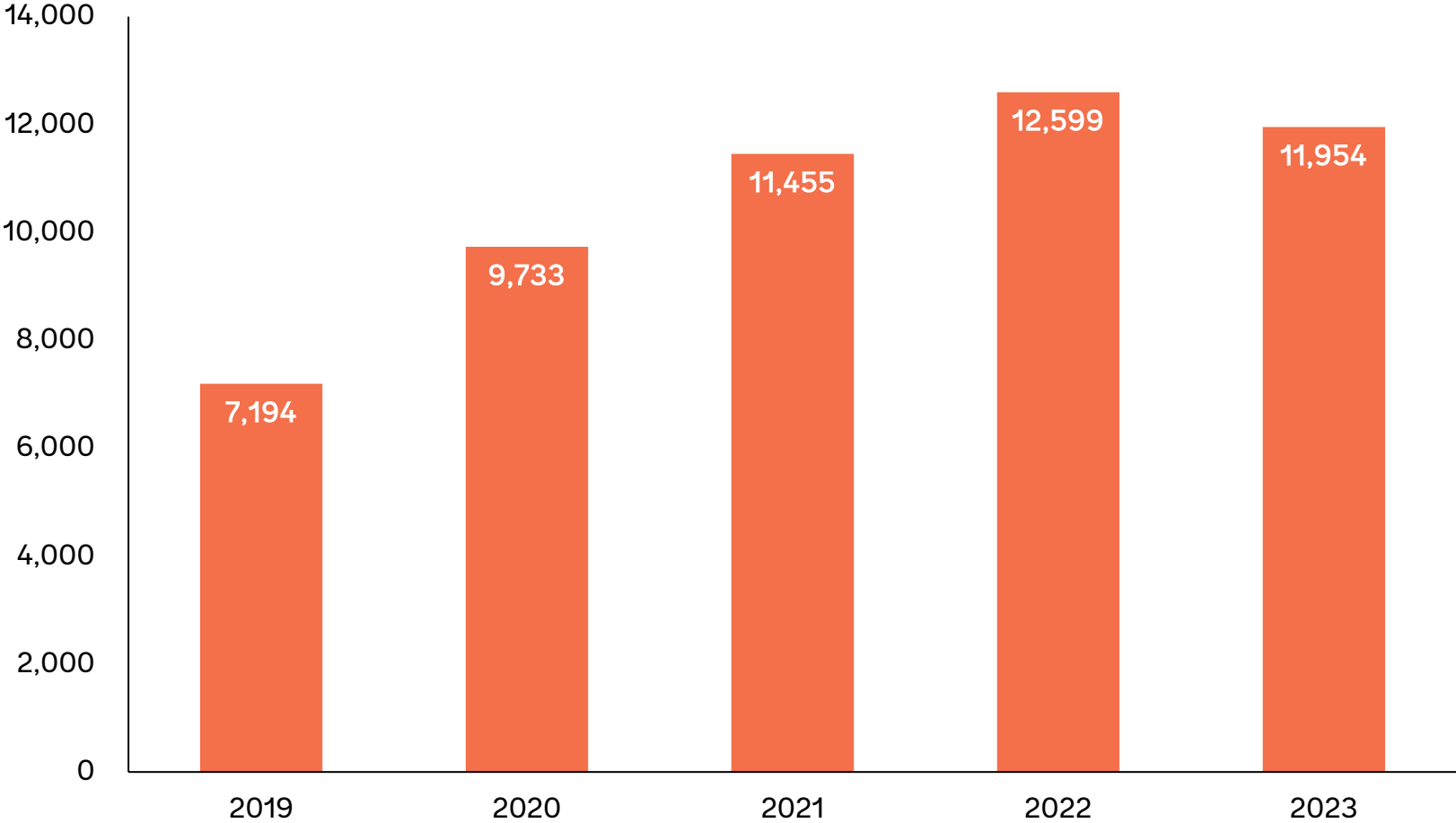

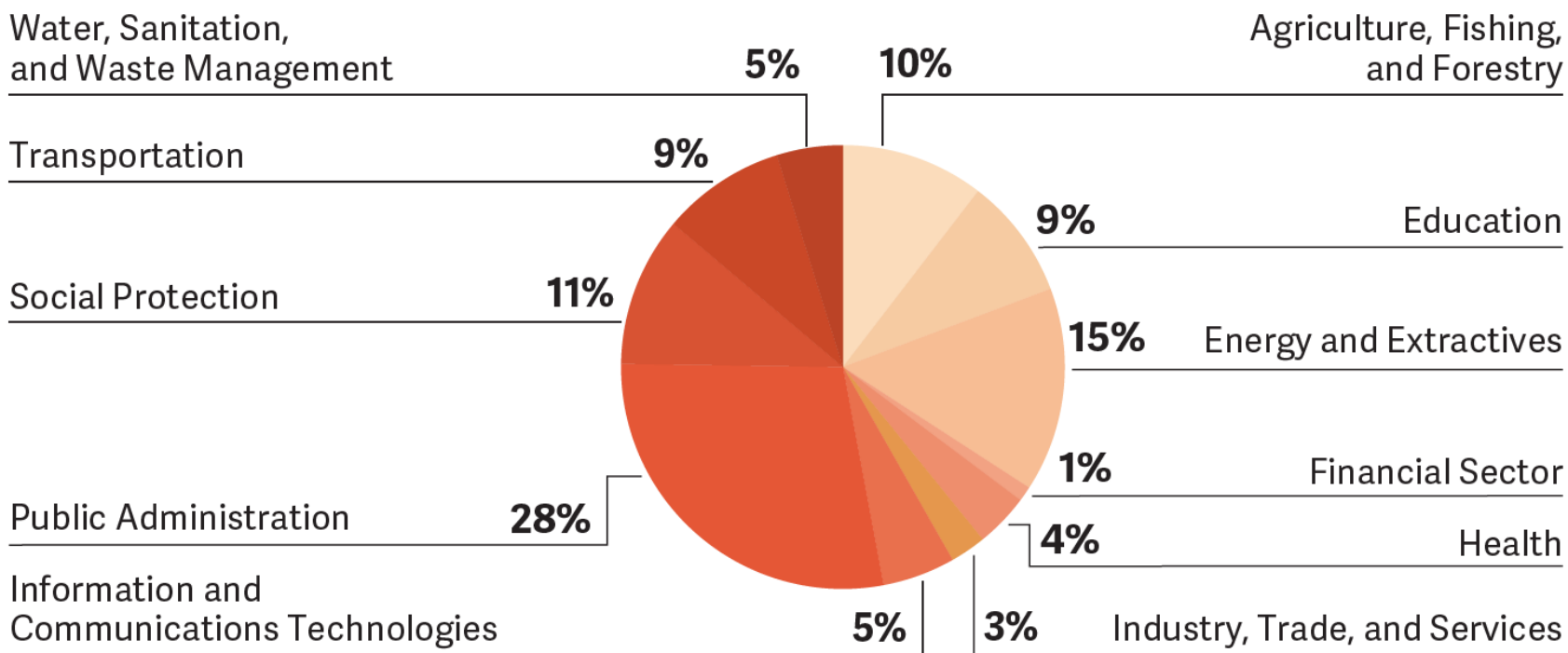

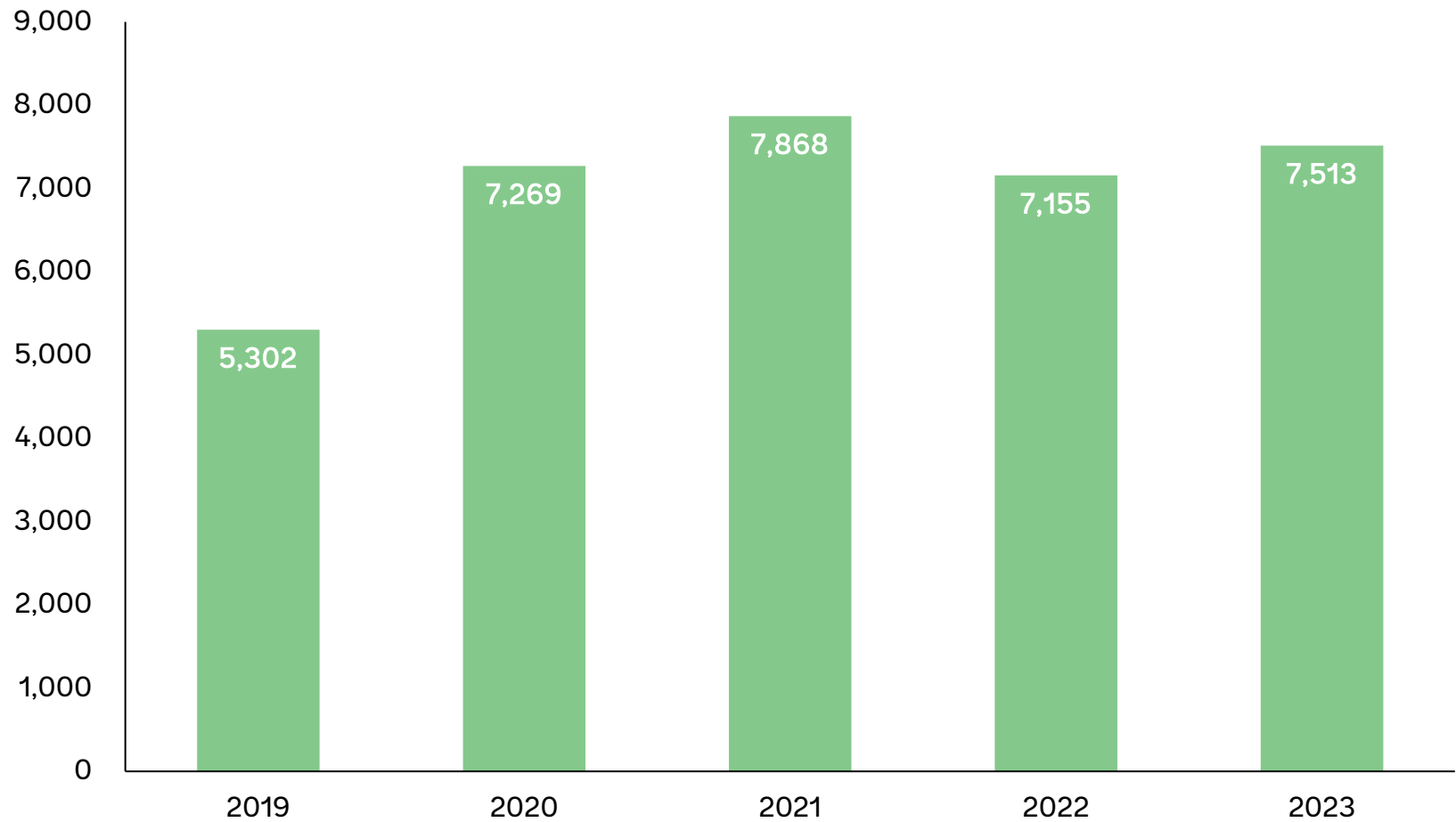

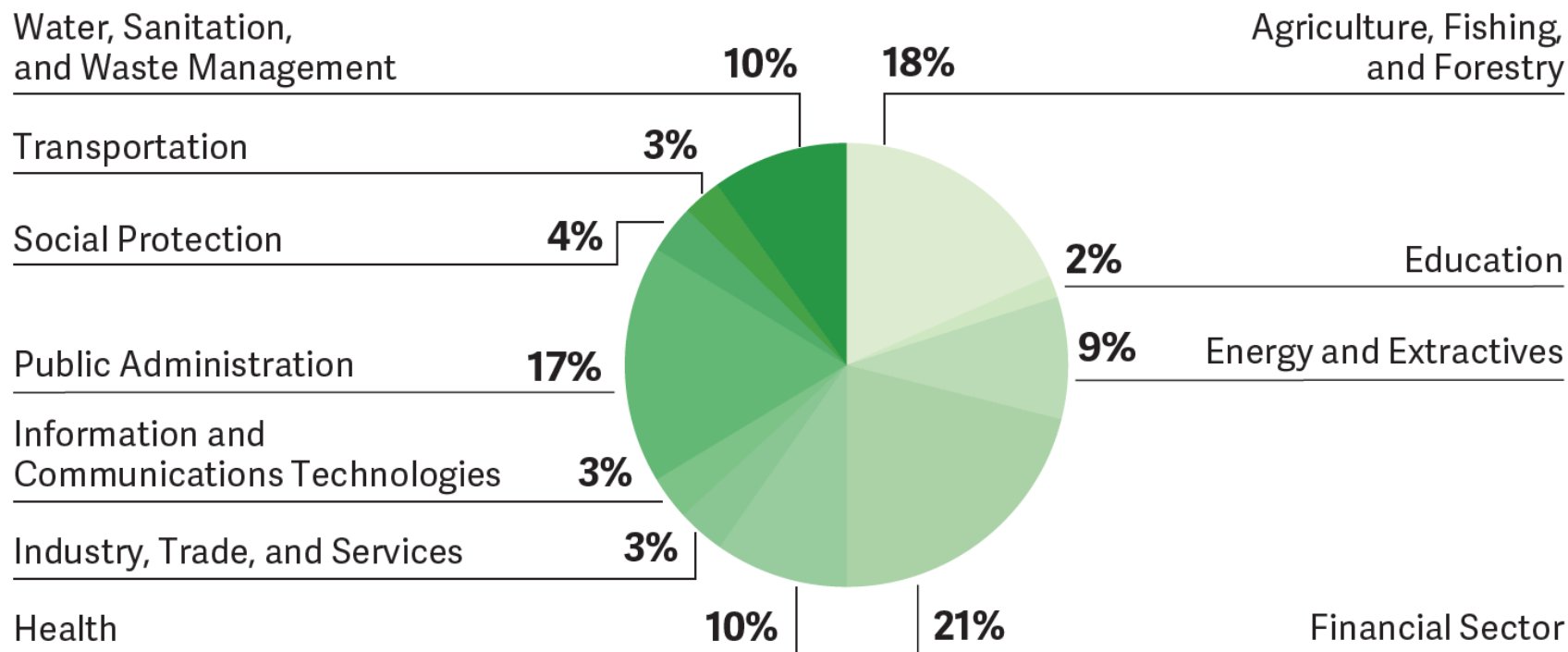

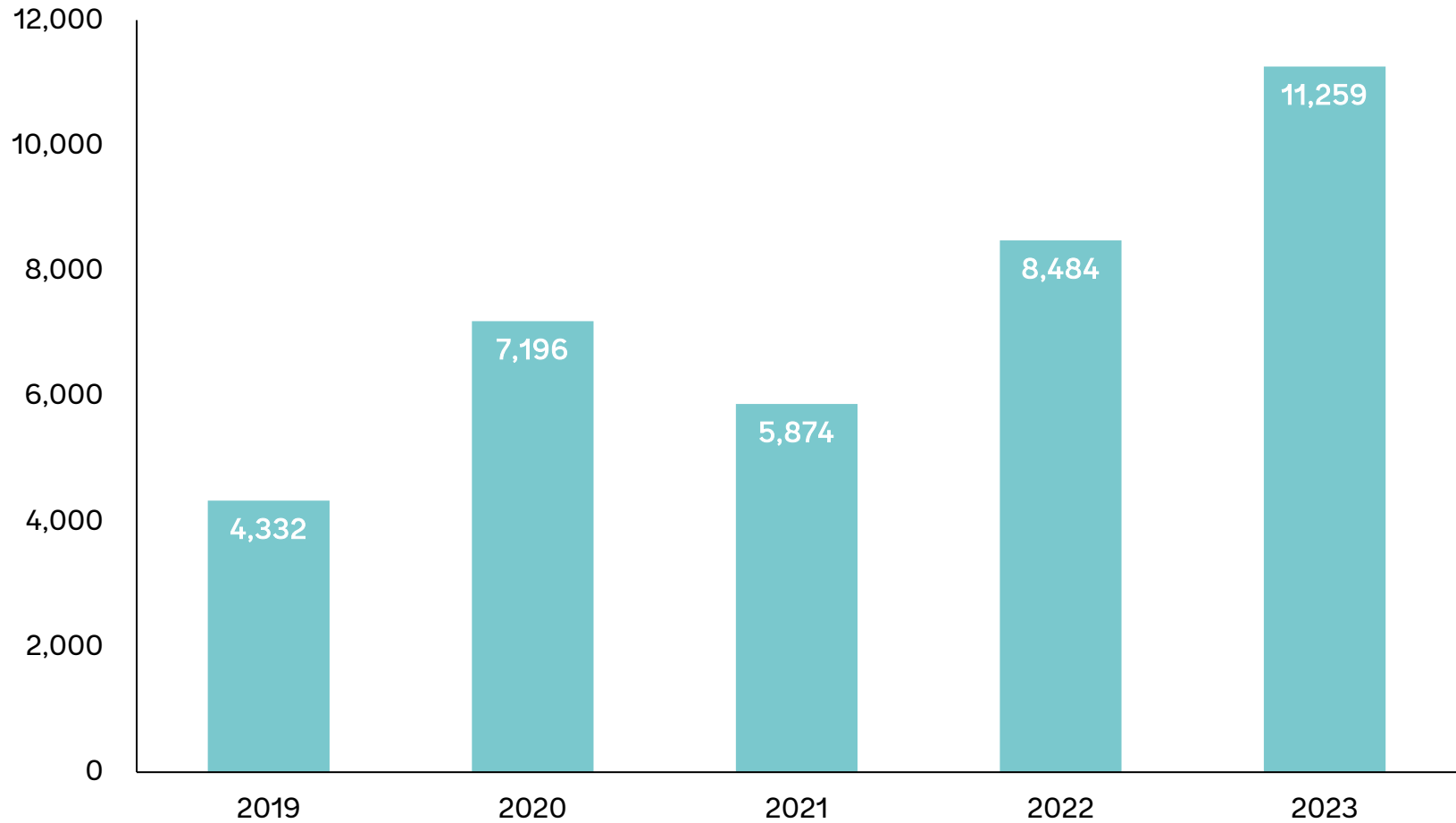

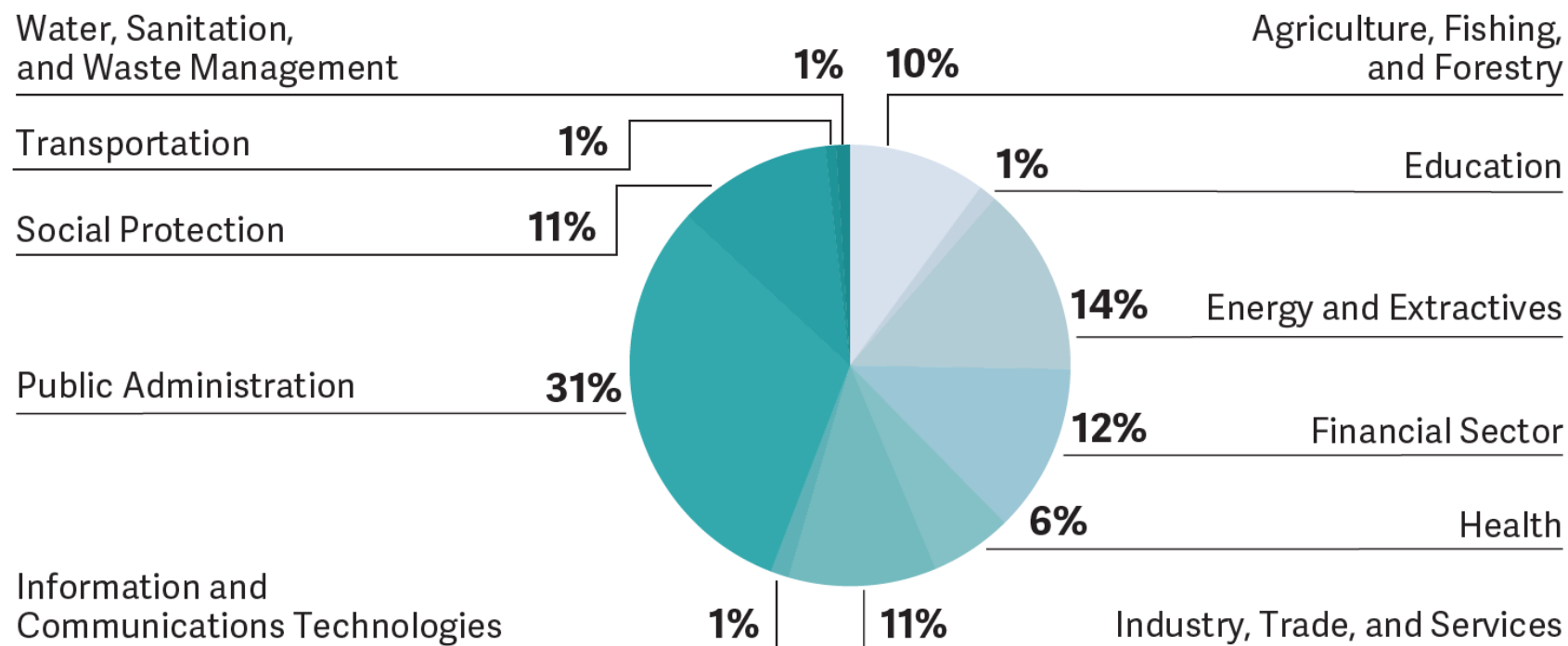

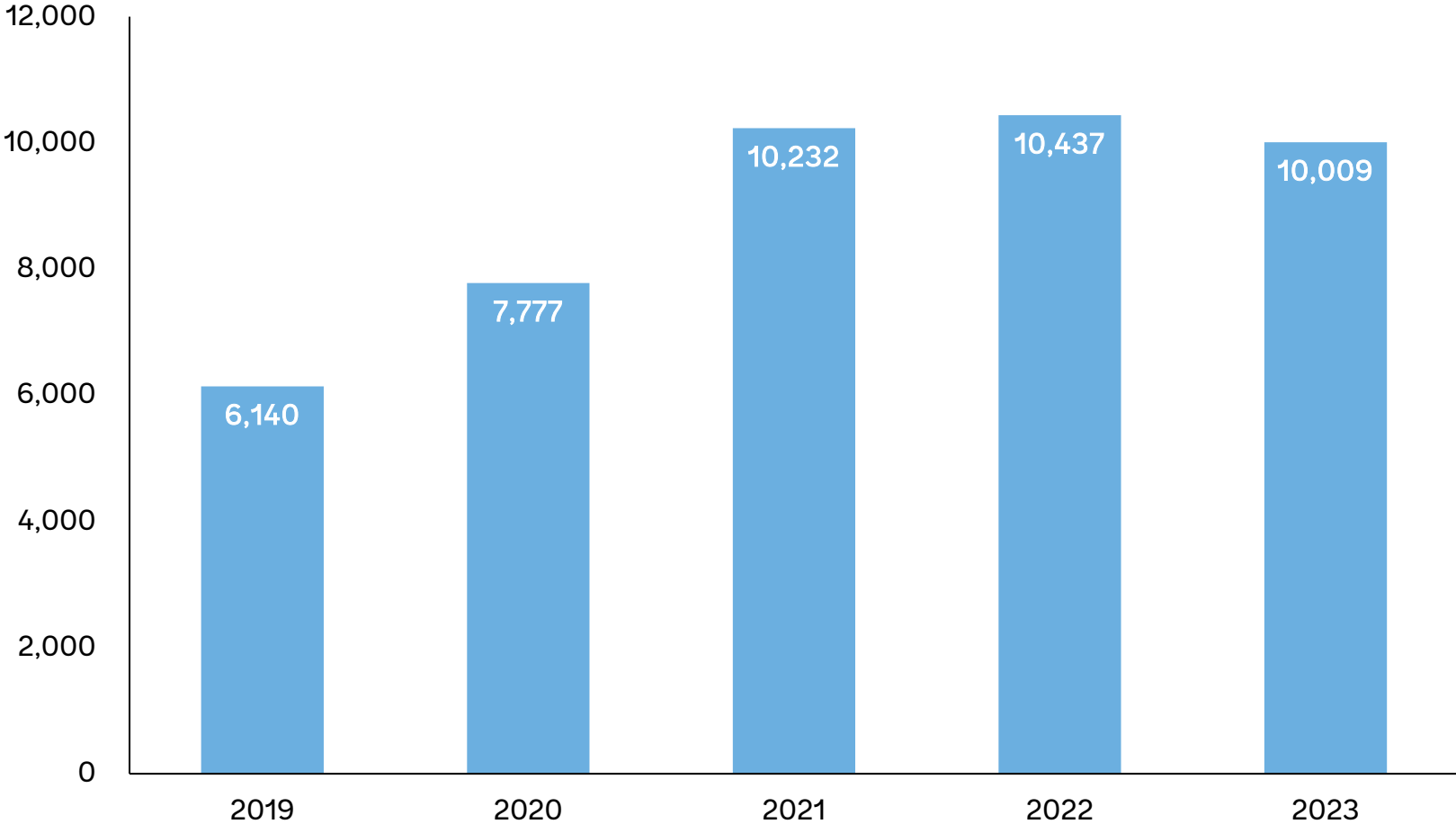

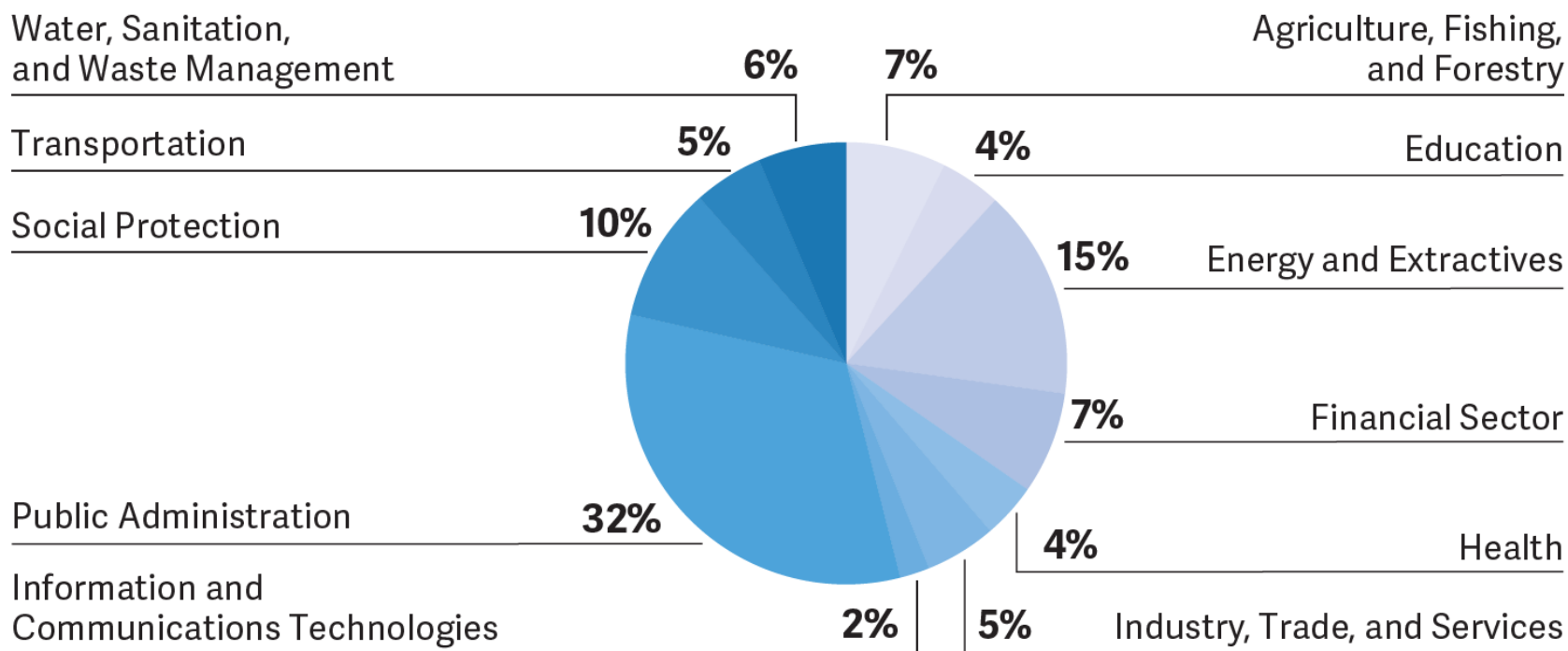

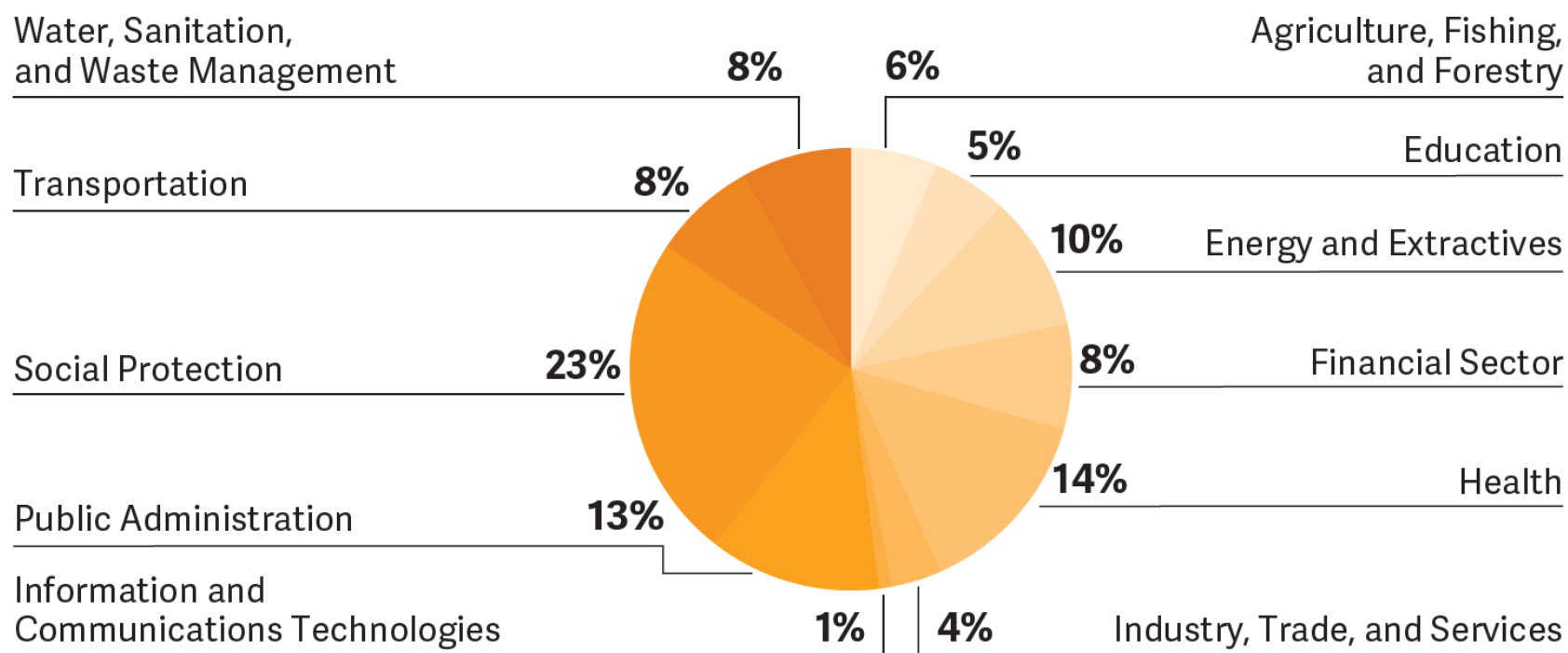

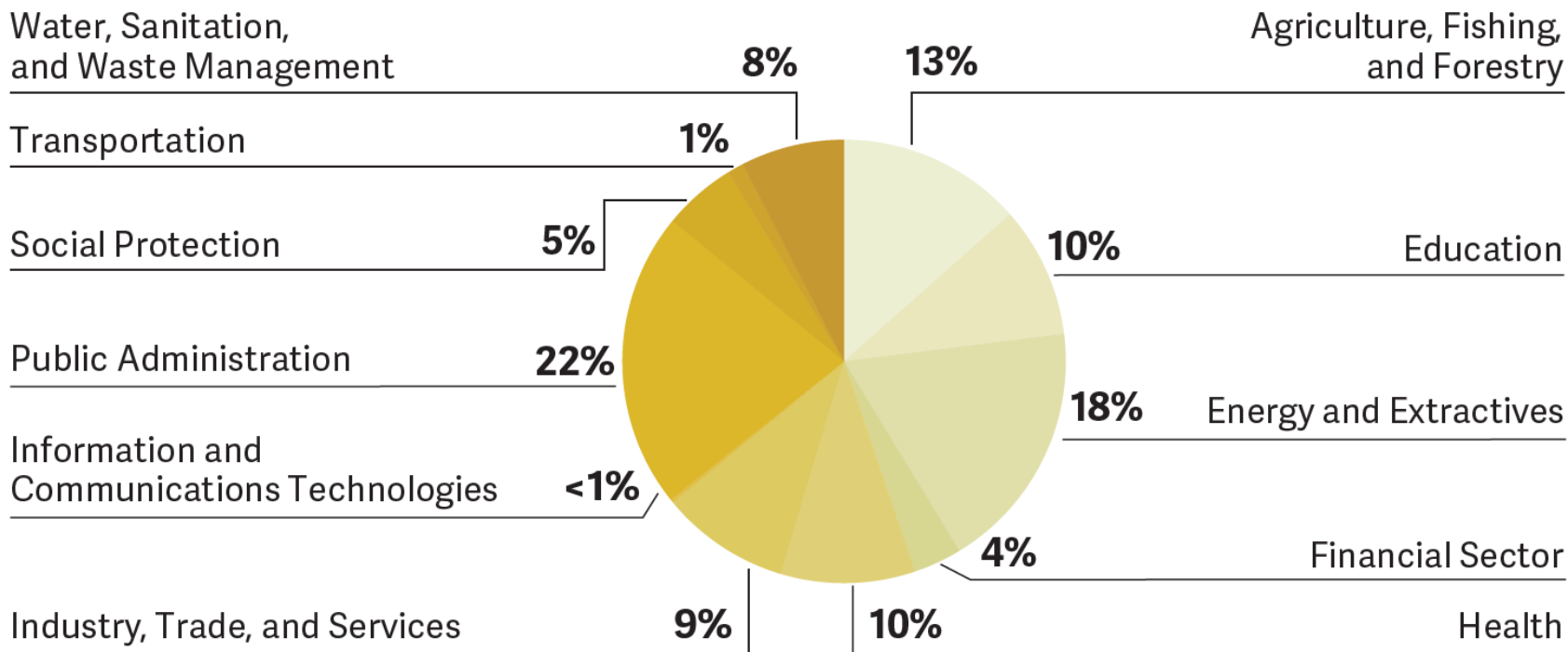

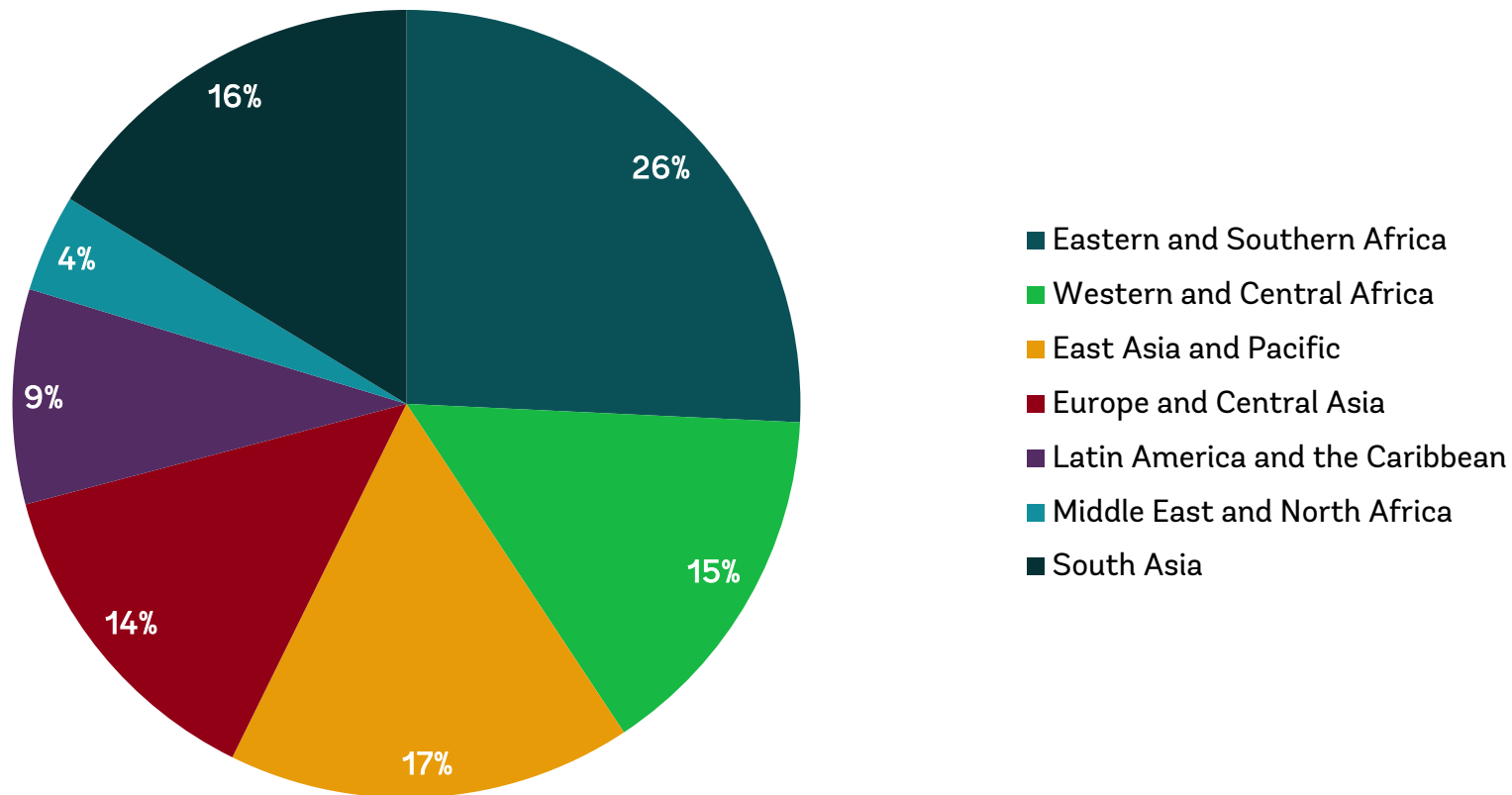

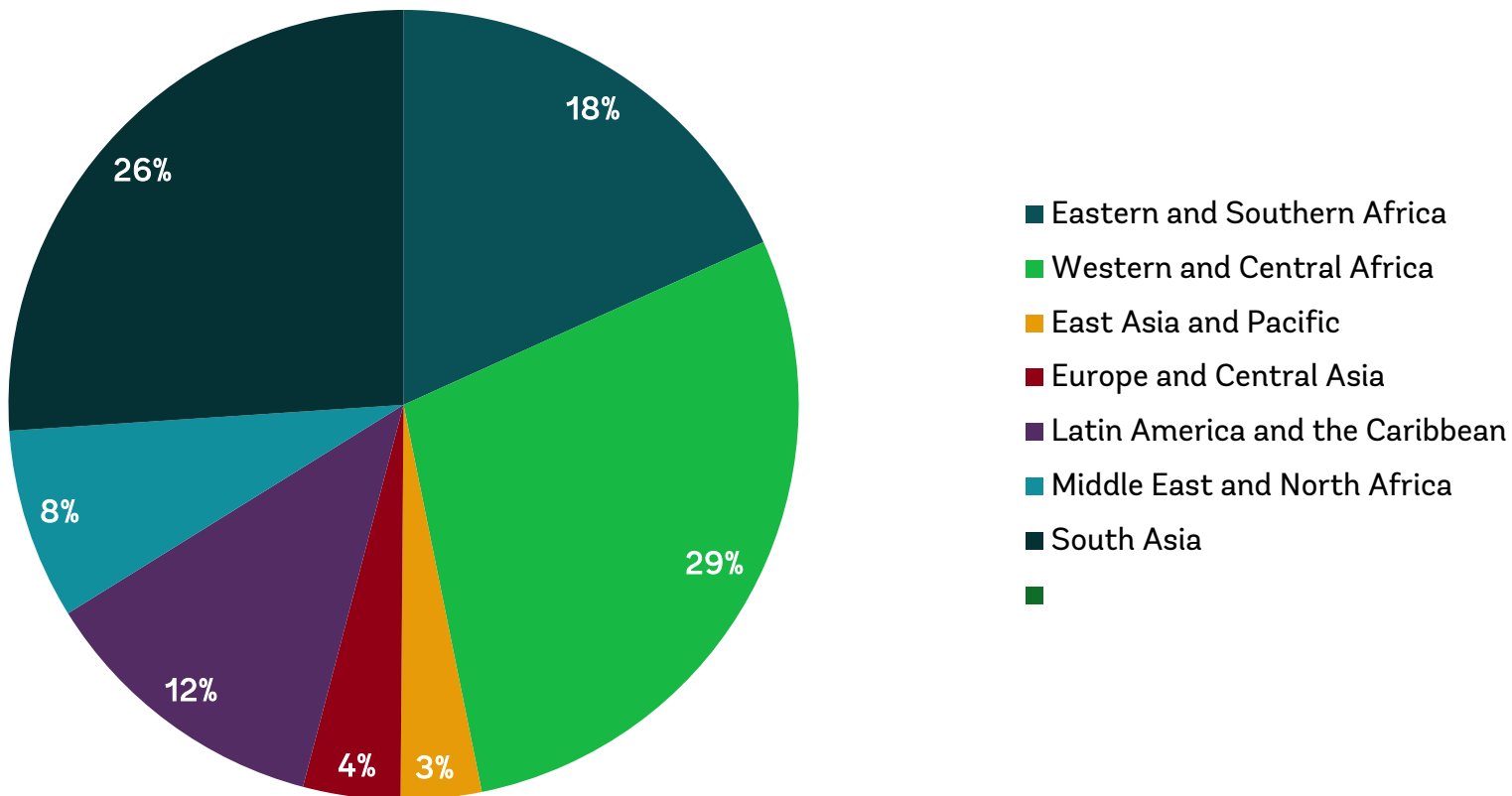
Share of total lending of \$8.3 billion

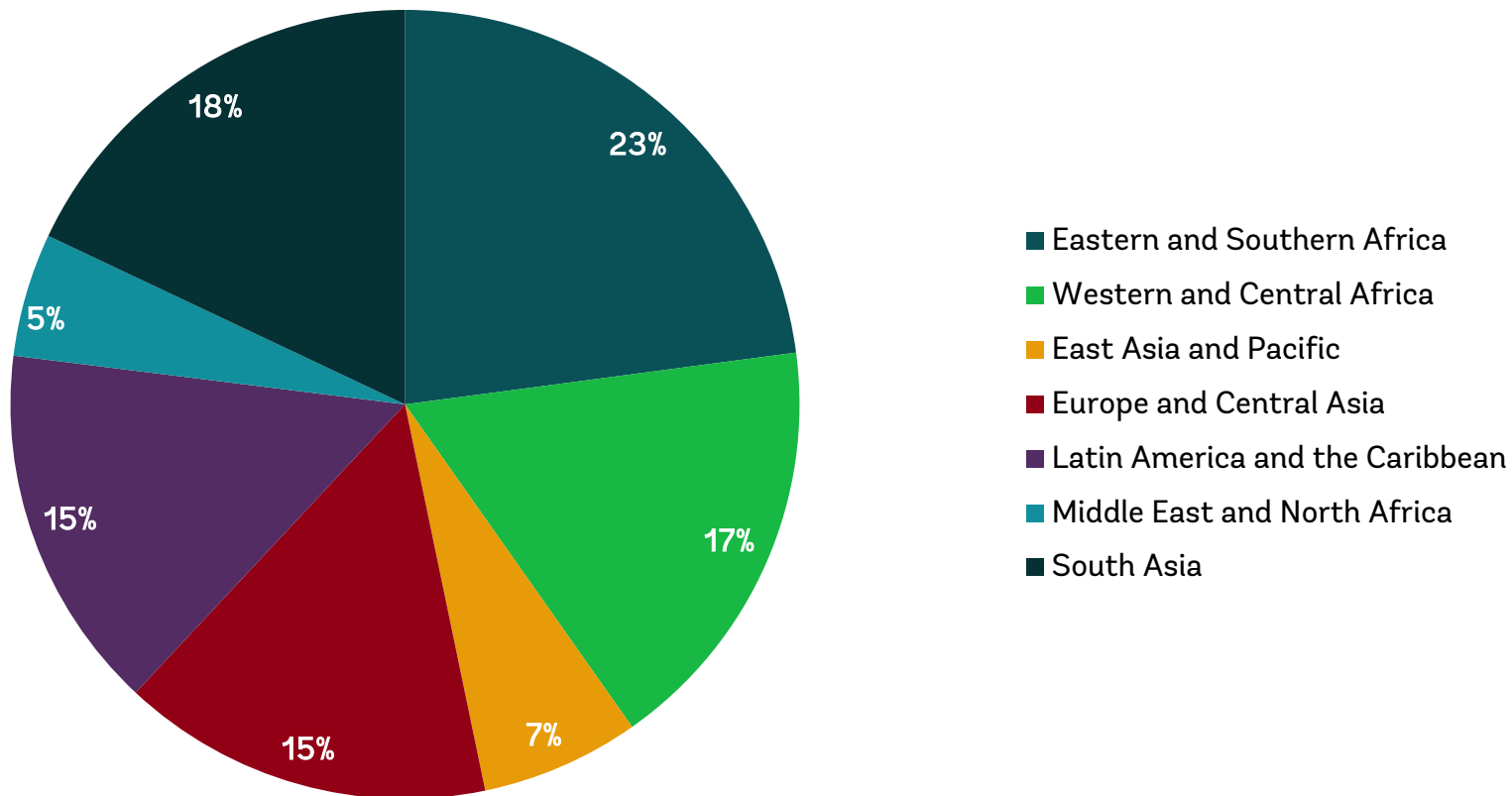
Share of total lending of \$3.7 billion

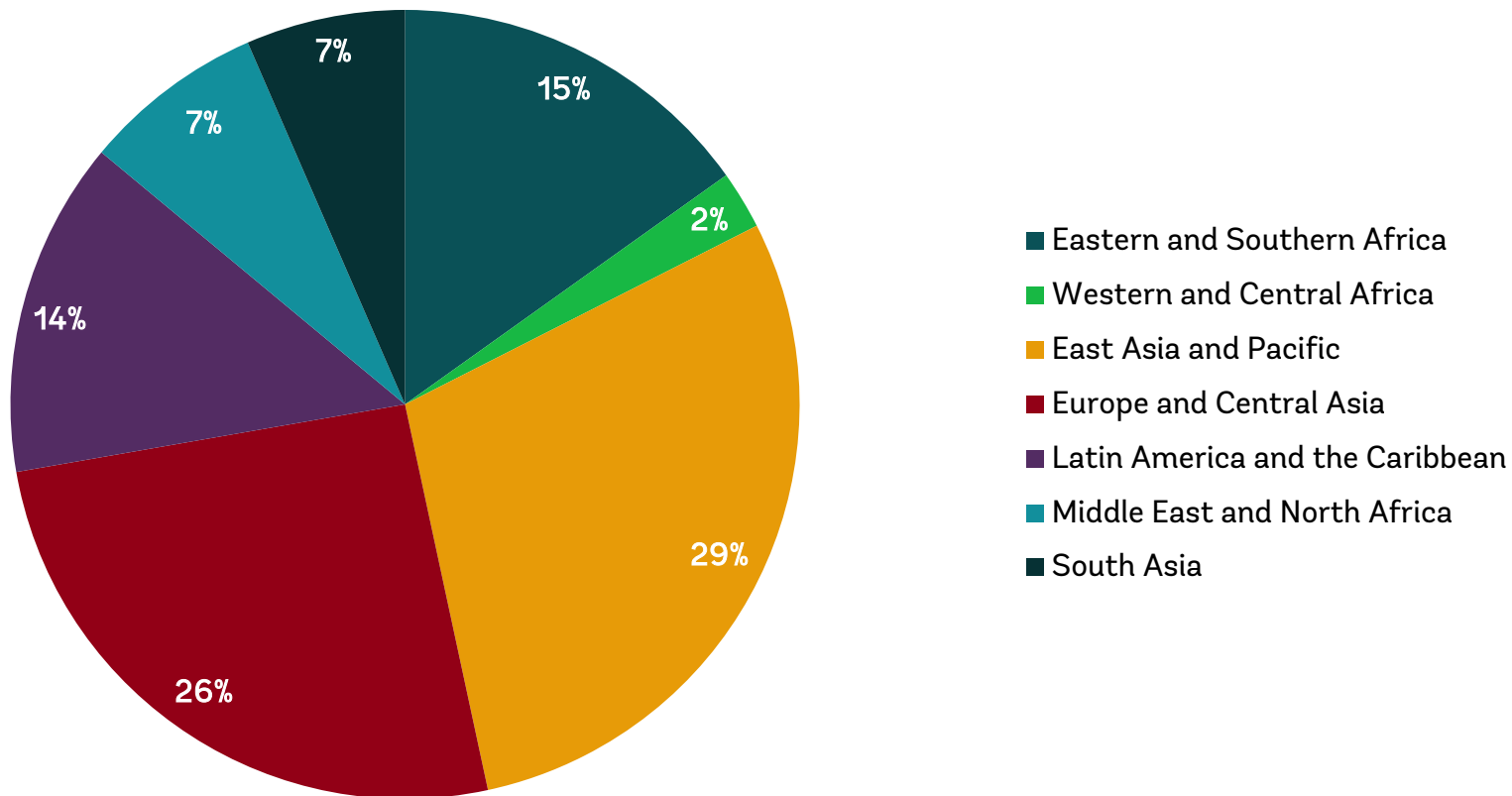
Share of total lending of \$10.3 billion

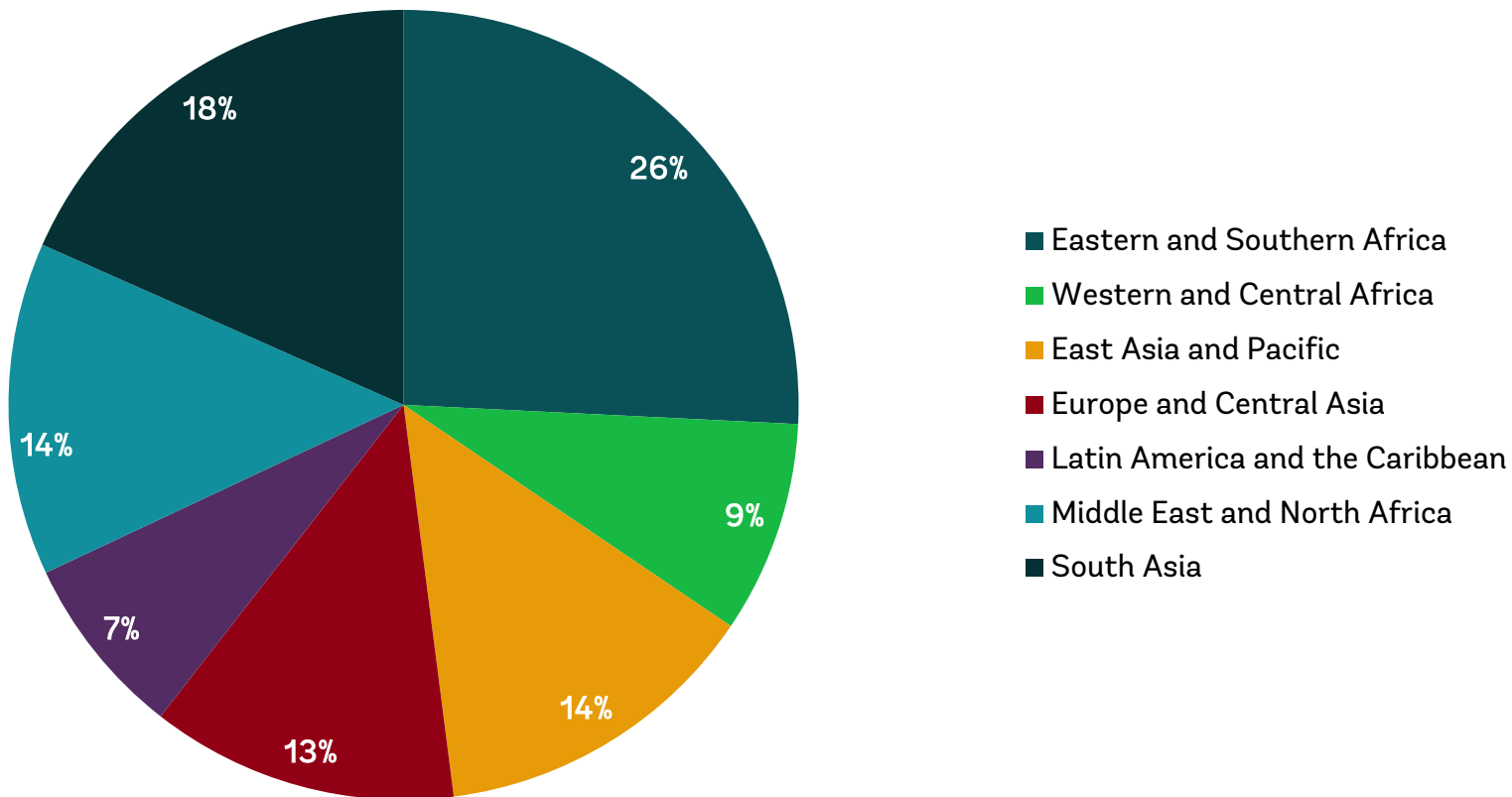

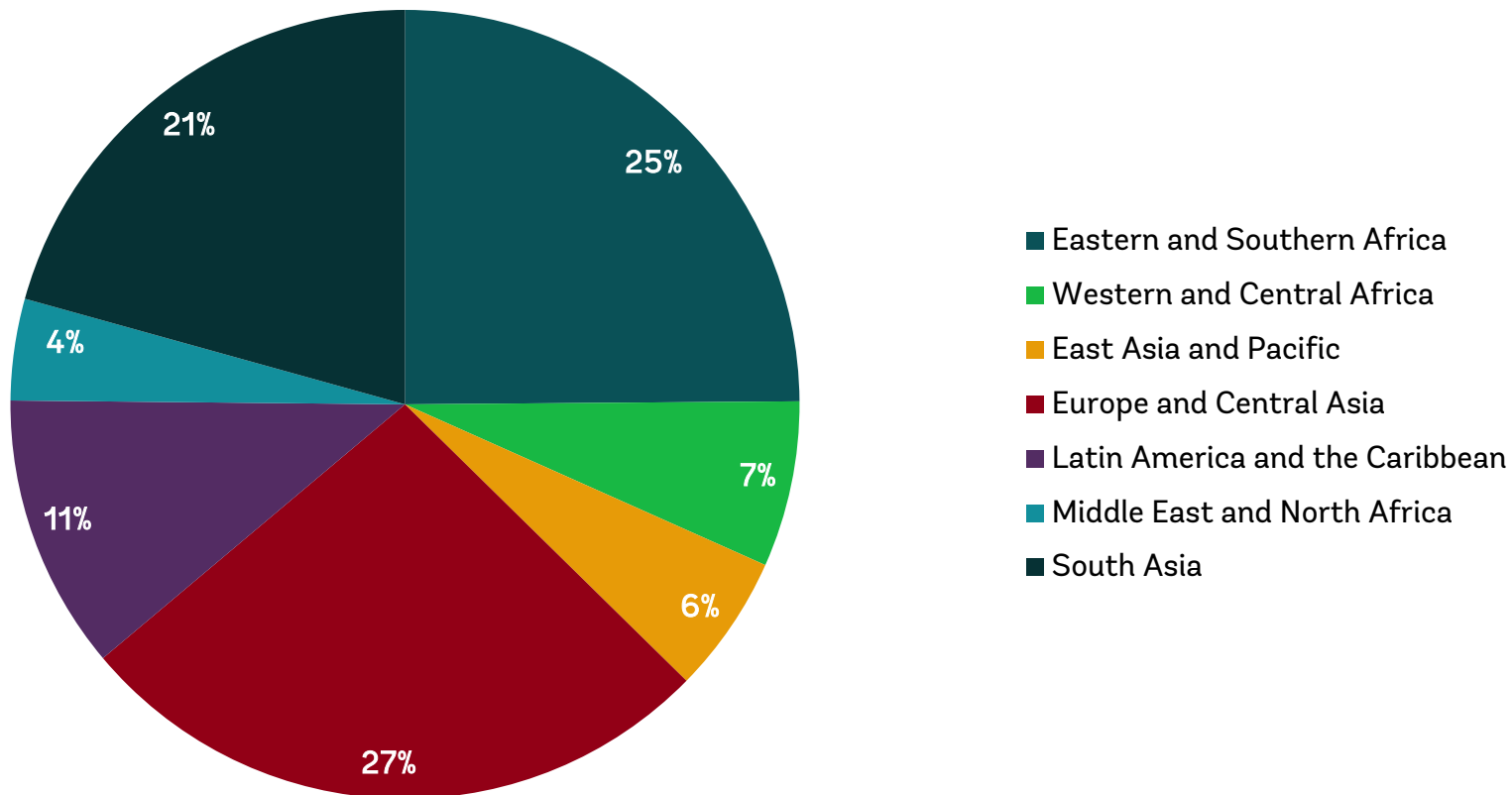

Industry, Trade, and Services IBRD and IDA Lending by Region | Fiscal 2023

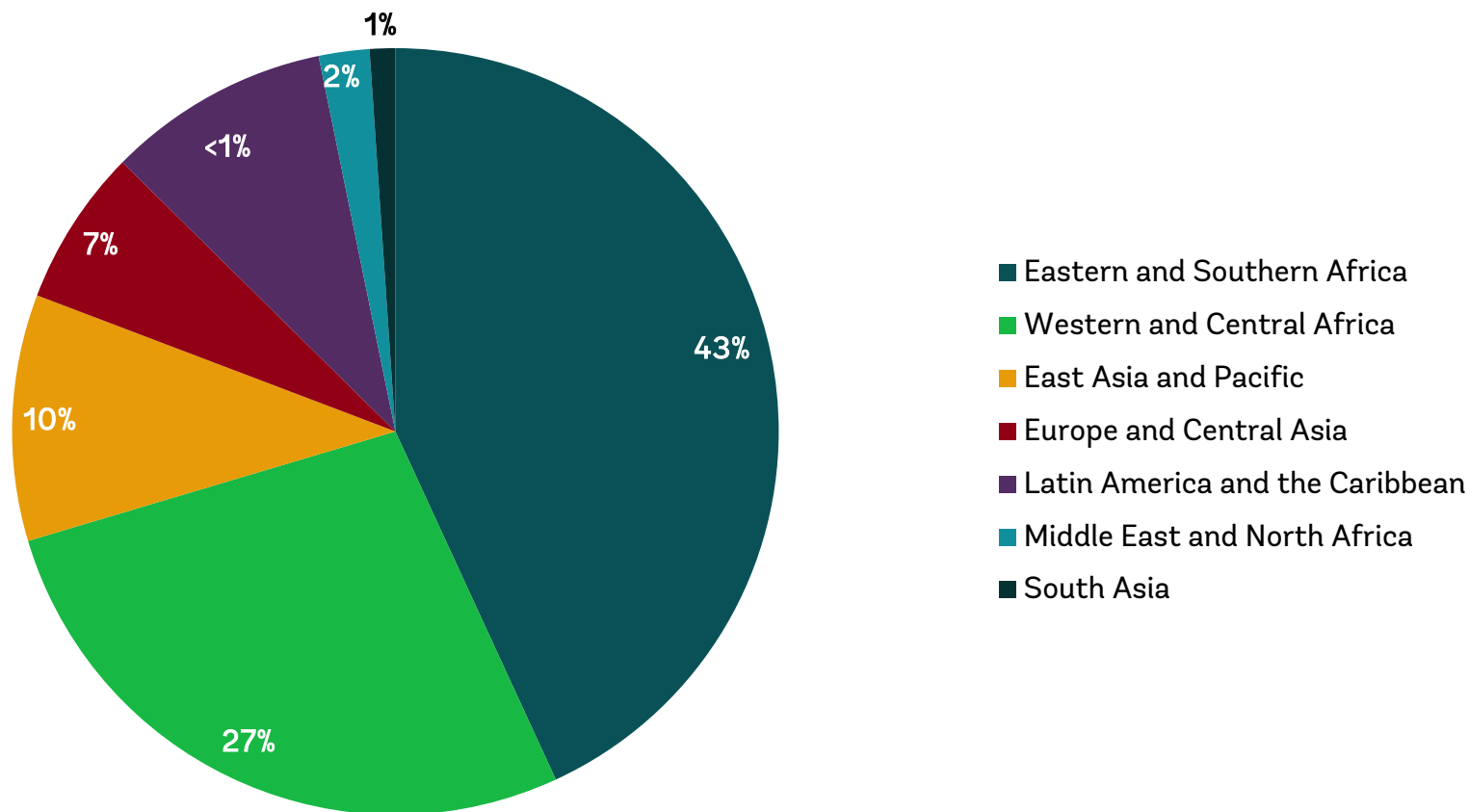
Share of total lending of \$4.6 billion

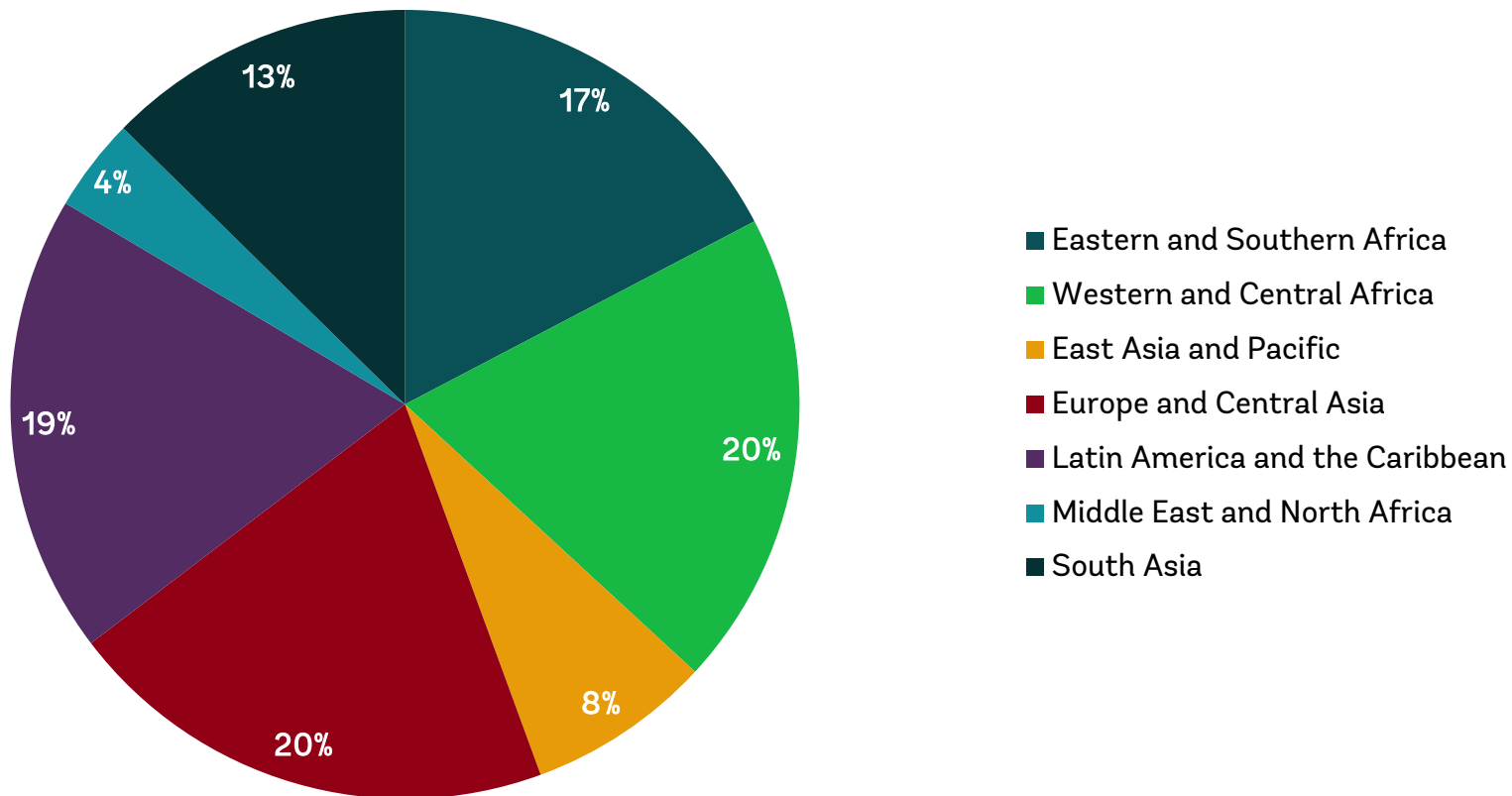
Share of total lending of \$2.3 billion

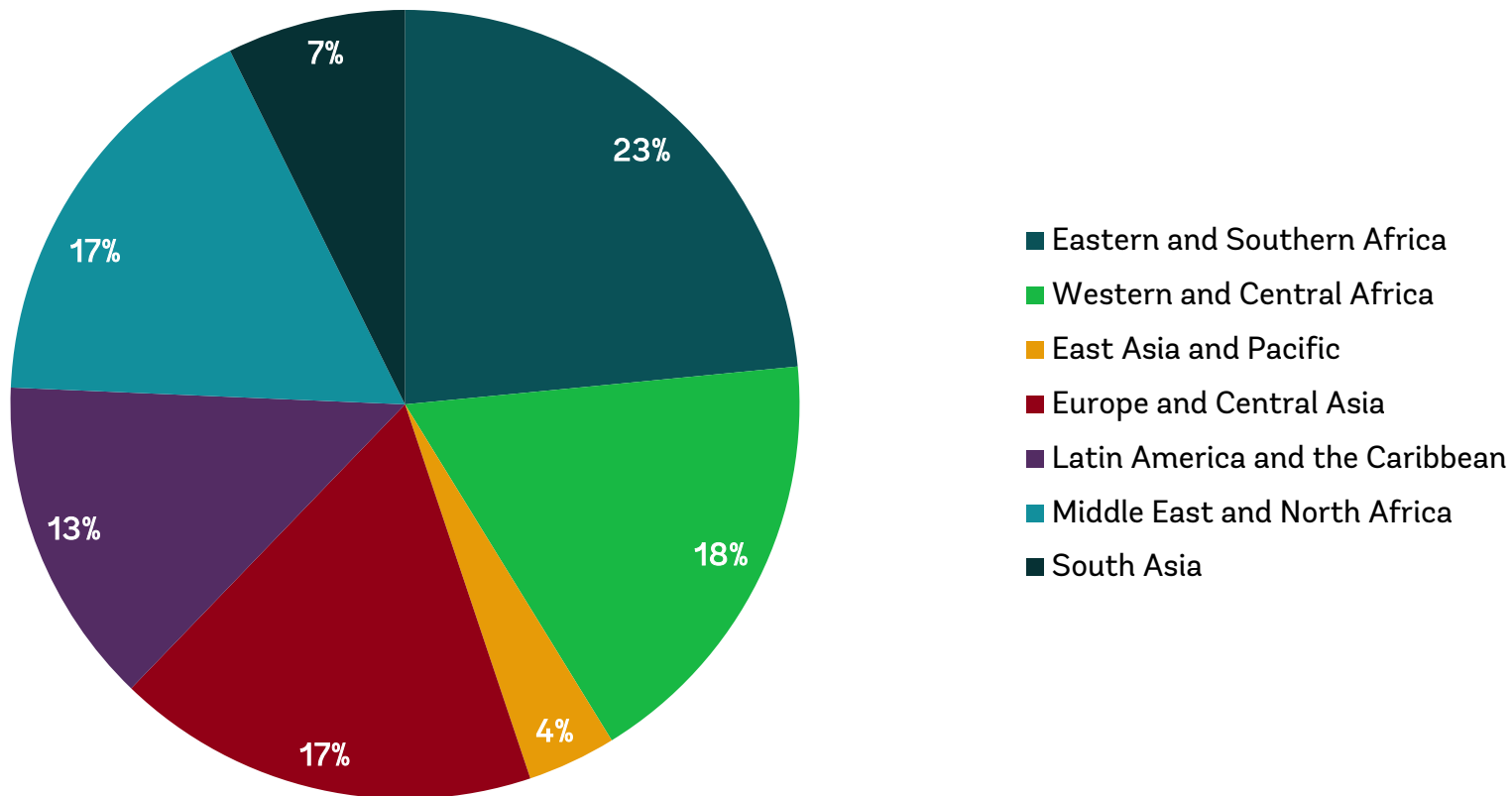
Share of total lending of \$17.2 billion

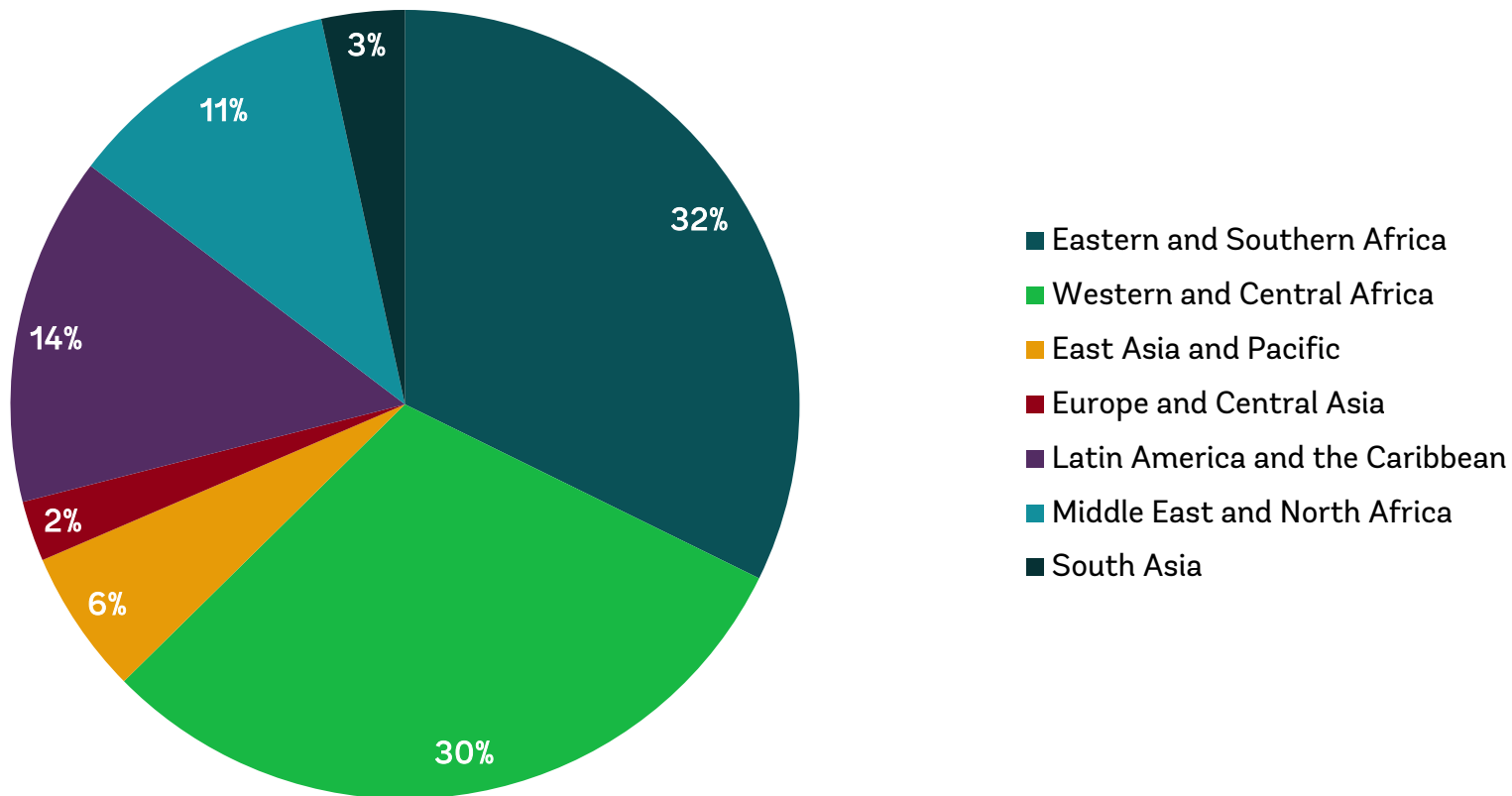
Share of total lending of \$7.4 billion

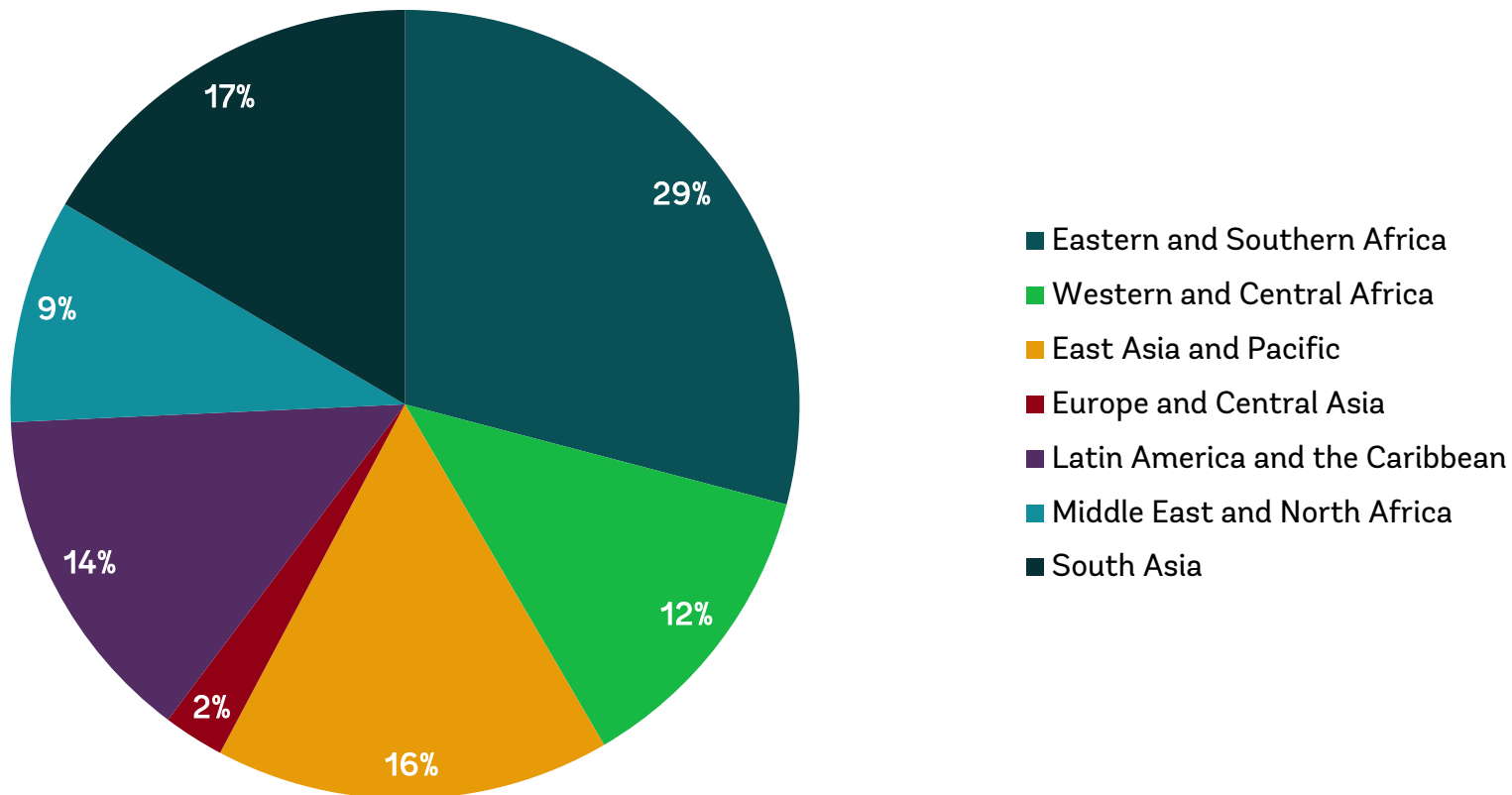
